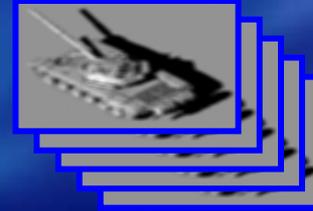


2D projection of a 3D world
