STATEMENT BY DR. MICHAEL S. FRANCIS

DIRECTOR, JOINT UNMANNED COMBAT AIR SYSTEMS PROGRAM

The Joint Unmanned Combat Air Systems (J-UCAS) Program has selected the Air Force Flight Test Center at Edwards Air Force Base, Calif., as the site of planned initial flight testing for the J-UCAS program. These initial operations will be followed by detachment and deployment activities at Holloman Air Force Base, N.M., later in the program as J-UCAS transitions to operationally oriented warfighter assessments.

The decision follows a months-long review of potential J-UCAS sites for the Operational Assessment by the combined DARPA, Air Force, and Navy J-UCAS site selection team.

Details of activities at each location will be finalized over the coming months.
